Minutes to Selectmen's Meeting July 12, 2018

Present: Wayne Infinger, Micah Voter, Jason Eastman, Tricia Pitman, and Bill Briggs.

Minutes to the last meeting were accepted.

Vouchers were reviewed and signed.

2 timber warrants were reviewed and signed.

Form PA-16 (value of federal land) was reviewed and signed.

The MS 535 was reviewed and signed.

Drive way permit for Chris Logan was received from the DOT.

The Selectmen were informed that The Association for Parrot C.A. Lockwood Animal Rescue Center was sent a letter requesting the financial forms required to be considered for tax exemption.

The Democratic Party asked that the Selectmen appoint Ellie Eastman and Judy Bailey to be the inspectors of the election this fall. Bill Briggs was appointed to be the inspector for the Republican Party.

Jeannine Devincent sent a letter to the Selectmen sharing her concerns over brush that was cut on her property and a faded road sign. Wayne Infinger is going to look into her concerns. Alan Eastman will be asked to put up a new sign.

The Class Action form for PILT payments was signed and will be sent in. Jason Eastman will be the contact person for this.

Jeff Stone will be sent a thank you note for cleaning up the beach area and putting in a picnic table for people to enjoy.

The AARP letter requested by the Gibson Center was sent and a copy will be filed. The Municipal Agent paperwork was sent to the State. Wayne Infinger asked that a form from Primex be sent to the DMV stating that the town does have bond coverage for the town clerk and deputy clerk.

Ron Briggs gave Wayne Infinger an update on the airport representative paperwork.

The Selectmen reviewed the changes made to the Master Plan by the Planning Board. The Selectmen approved the changes.

The changes that were made were: the plan is now single paged, Table 4 was updated, table 5 was deleted (Carroll County population), update economic base table, nursing homes updated, location of housing was deleted.

Updated on the well, water should be available next week.

Other: The two town safes that were outside of the town hall may have been dumped behind the cemetery. The Selectmen will check with Alan Eastman to see if he knows about this. The Selectmen will also check with Alan on repairing the stone wall behind the town house.
