Jim Innis had contacted the town to discuss the bridge that is located on Deer Hill Road. It was explained to Mr. Innis that the bridge is in the town of Stow.

Bill Perry wanted to know if the town would support Spectrum bringing cable to the town. The Selectmen stated that they would support it but were not willing to fund the project using town money.
